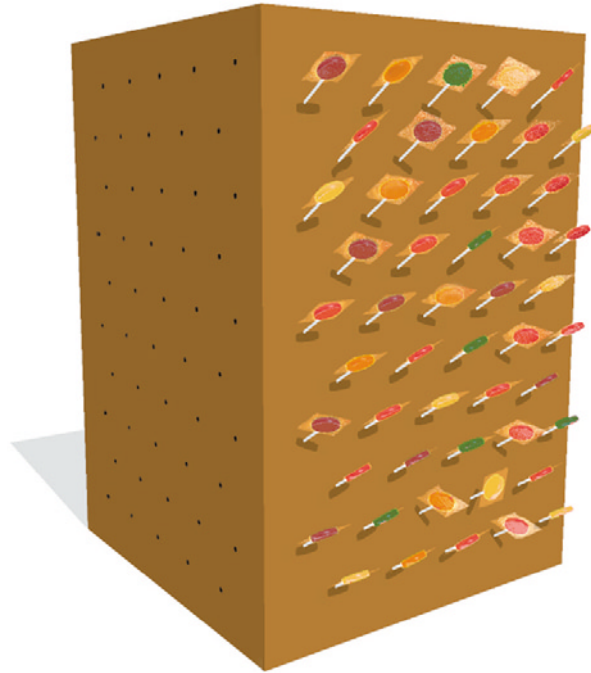


Let the Games Begin!

It's time to bring out the kid in everyone! The following section is loaded with games and activities perfect for your carnival festivities. No matter what time of the season, winter, spring, summer or fall, inside or outside, these activities can be easily adapted to fit your needs.

- They are inexpensive and many can be made out of scraps of wood, cardboard and other donated materials.
- They can easily be modified to fit various skill levels, age groups and available space.
- Not only are they great for carnivals, they're great for; company picnics, birthday parties, office parties, holiday parties, and social events.

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Lollipop Game

A great game for young children. Requires very little skill and everyone is a winner.

Usual Charge1 ticket for 50¢

GoalPull a lollipop from the box

Blue stemLarge prize

Red stemMedium prize

Green stemSmall prize

Unmarked stem . . .Consolation prize

From cardboard, construct a 4-sided box, each side 30" high and 20" wide. On each side of the box punch 10 rows of small holes, 5 holes in each row (50 holes per side). Stagger the holes so the box looks full when the suckers are added.



Using a colored marker, mark the stems of each lollipop as follows: 10 stems blue, 30 stems red, 60 stems green and leave 100 stems unmarked. Randomly place the lollipops in the slots of the box. The player receives the lollipop pulled and the prize that corresponds with the color of the stem. Refill the slots with a lollipop having the same color stem as pulled.

Ring Toss

This is a fun game for all ages.

Usual Charge3 rings for 50¢

GoalHook rings for a prize

3 ringsLarge prize

2 ringsMedium prize

1 ringSmall prize

0 ringConsolation prize

Make a line with tape for the player to stand behind. Each player gets three chances to hook rings for prizes. Prizes awarded correspond to total number of rings that are hooked in three tosses.

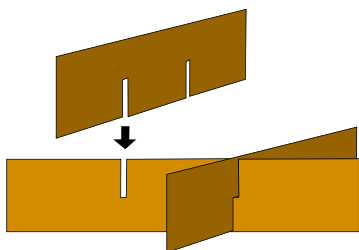

Set pins in traditional 10-pin bowling formation. Make a line with tape for the player to stand behind. Each player gets 2 rolls to knock down as many pins as possible. Prizes awarded correspond to the total number of pins

knocked down in two rolls. Length of your alley depends upon how much room you have. Move younger players closer to the pins.



Sponge Ball Tic Tac Toe

Usual Charge: 4 sponge balls for 50¢

Goal: 3 balls in a diagonal, vertical or horizontal line

Diagonal, vertical

or horizontal lineLarge prize

No lineConsolation prize

Player is given 4 sponge balls to throw in the box. To be a winner, 3 balls must land in a diagonal, vertical or horizontal line. Adjust distance from the target according to the age level of the player.

Cut a 12" x 12" cardboard box down 4" in height. Keep extra cardboard. Cut four strips of cardboard 11-3/4" x 3". These will be used to make the squares for the balls to land in. Interlock the four strips of cardboard and place inside box as shown in the picture.

Using the extra cardboard, cut three 12" x 8" pieces and slide each piece down into the box along each side, leaving the front side open. Bend each panel. Cut triangular pieces to fit into the corners between the panels and tape them to the panels. This will keep the balls inside the box and will also hold the top pieces in place at an angle. Using a marker or crayon, label the game as shown in the picture and have fun!

Basketball Game

Usual Charge: 3 tosses for 50¢

Goal: Make three baskets with three tosses

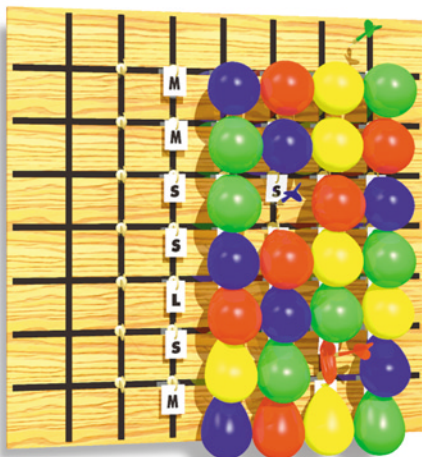
Three baskets.....Large prize

Two baskets.....Medium prize

One basketSmall prize

No baskets.....Consolation prize

Adjust the distance to the hoop according to the skill and age level of each player. Each player receives 3 tosses. The prize awarded corresponds to the number of baskets made. Be sure to have plenty of basketballs available and close off the throwing area with pennants to keep the game moving quickly. Have a back stop to control loose balls.



Dart Games

Game: Balloon Tag

Usual Charge: 50¢

Goal: Break a balloon and win a prize

Win: Consolation, Small, Medium & Large prizes

On a 4' x 4' piece of plywood, use a heavy permanent marker or tape to draw horizontal and vertical lines at 6" intervals. Insert cup hooks at intersections (49 total). Prepare 150 - 1" x 1" tags with a punch hole center at top.

Mark 80 tags with a **C** (for consolation prize), 45 tags with **S** (for

small prize), 15 tags with **M** (for medium prize) and 10 tags with **L** (for large prize). Randomly place 3 **L** tags, 5 **M** tags, 15 **S** tags and 27 **C** tags with the letters facing the board, blank side up. Keep the remaining tags in a box. Place an inflated 4" balloon on each hook. Place the

board upright 5' from the front of the booth from where the player will throw. The player throws darts until a balloon is broken.

The letter on the hook of the broken balloon determines what level of prize the player wins. Replace the tag with one from the box and replace the broken balloon. The profit of this game can be controlled by manipulating the number of corresponding tags. Ex: Higher percentage of **S** tags means higher profit.

Use darts only under adult supervision!

Dart Throw

Usual Charge: 3 darts for 50¢

Goal: BULL'S-EYE!

3 bull's-eyes.....JUMBO PRIZE!

Black ring.....Large prize

Red ringMedium prize

Blue ringSmall prize

No rings.....Consolation prize

On a large cardboard box, draw an outer 18" circle divided at 6-inch intervals. Color the inner ring black, middle ring red and outer ring blue. Place the box on a table and weigh it down so it does not tip over. Player stands 5' from target. Move older players farther back. Player gets 3 tries to land a dart on the target. Prizes awarded correspond to color ring hit. If more than one color ring is hit, award highest prize.



Milk Bottle Games

Game: Milk Bottle Throw

Usual Charge: 3 throws for 50¢

Goal: Knock all 3 bottles down

3 bottles with 1 throwLarge prize

3 bottles with 2 throwsMedium prize

3 bottles with 3 throwsSmall prize

1-2 bottles with 3 throwsConsolation prize

Player stands 5' - 8' from counter and has three throws to knock down all three milk bottles. Each player is awarded a large prize when knocking three bottles down in one throw. If not, player gets two more throws to knock down remaining bottles and wins prize value according to how many throws it took.

Game: Knock Down!

Usual Charge: 1 throw for 50¢

Goal: Knock down all 3 bottles with one throw

Win: Medium, Large or Jumbo prize



Aluminum One-Pound Milk Bottles 8"

Player stands 5' - 8' from counter.

Player gets one throw to knock down all three bottles. By knocking

down all three on the first throw player wins a Medium prize - OR - the option TO TRADE UP the prize and play Round Two for another 50¢. In Round Two, if the player knocks down all three bottles on one throw, the player wins a large prize AND advances to Round Three for one FREE throw. If the player wins Round

Three, the player trades up the large prize for a jumbo prize. If the player loses in Round One, they receive a Consolation prize. If the player loses in Round Two or Three, they keep the previous prize already won.

Suggested Poster:

Round One for 50¢WINS! Medium prize

Round Two for 50¢WINS! Trade up for a Large prize AND FREE ROUND

Round Three FREE throw...WINS! Trade up for a JUMBO PRIZE!

Football Throw

Usual Charge: 3 throws for 50¢

Goal: Throw all 3 footballs through the tire

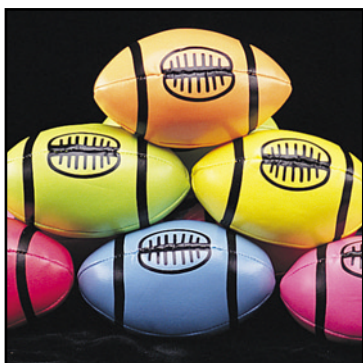
3 balls through.....Large prize

2 balls through.....Medium prize

1 ball throughSmall prize

0 balls through.....Consolation prize

Hang a tire shoulder height 8' -12' from where the player will stand. Each player receives 3 throws. The prize awarded corresponds to the number of footballs thrown through the tire. Be sure to have plenty of footballs available and to keep the game moving quickly. Use a back stop to control loose balls. For older players, gently spin the tire for added difficulty.

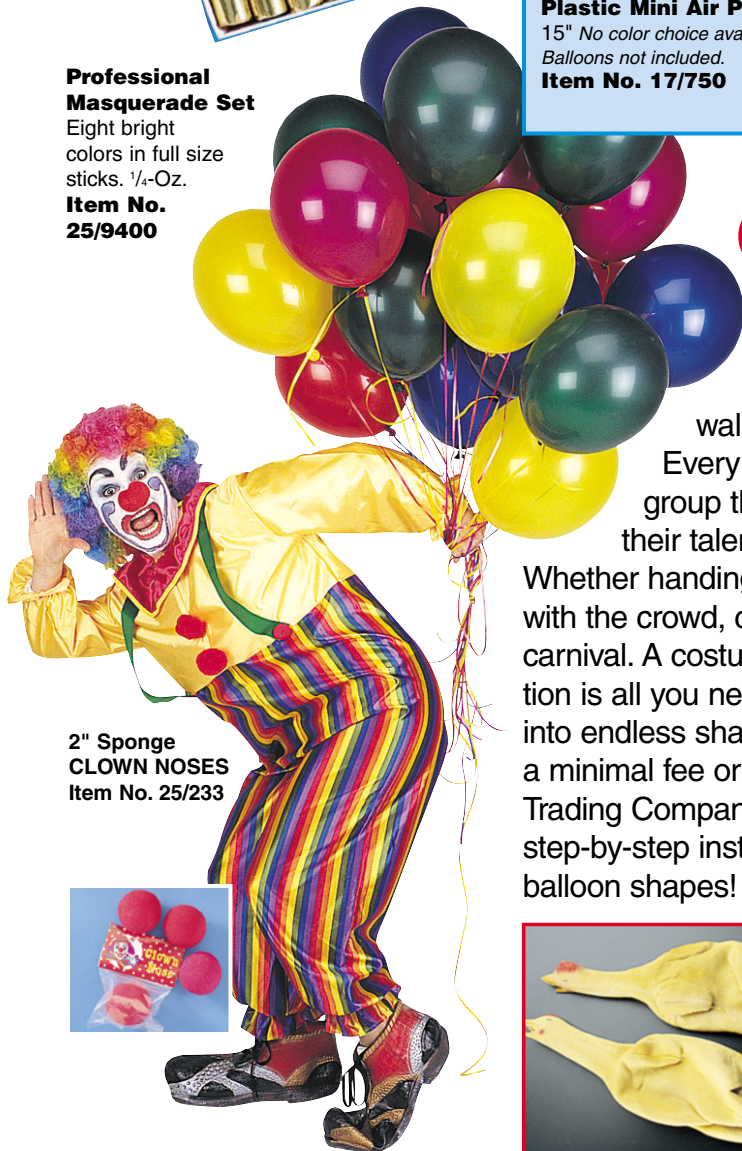

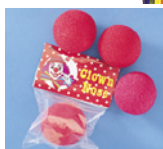

Games and Game Supplies

Add Variety to Your Carnival

Kee in mind there are other ways besides game booths to make your carnival a success. And what would a carnival be without food? Here are some additional ideas to consider when planning your carnival.

Food Sales

This is a sure way to make a profit. For a small fee you can keep everyone happy while serving up some great treats. Find that volunteer who loves to cook. Hot dogs and hamburgers cooked on an outside grill will fill the air with that great barbecue aroma. You'll have 'em coming back for more. Popcorn, nachos, and pizza are also



very popular food items. Desserts and sweets like cotton candy, homemade cookies, candied apples and candy are always a hit. Be sure to have plenty of beverages to last the day. Soda pop and bottled water are a must, especially on hot summer days. An ethnic food table is another way to get everyone in your organization involved. Let everyone be a chef and show off their specialties!

HELPFUL HINTS: When serving food and beverages, have plenty of napkins handy. If possible, use paper cups, paper plates and plastic utensils. Locate trash containers close to all food and beverage booths. This will make clean-up quick and easy. Make popcorn ahead of time and have it bagged before the carnival begins. Staple the bags shut.

Cake Walk

All cakes and pastries should be donated for this game. Pure profit every time. Or if you want to give out prizes, plush toys and dolls are very popular.

Usual Charge: 50¢ per day

Game Set-up: There are two different ways to set up this game. Set chairs in a circle, or if chairs are not available, use masking tape and mark a large area of the floor with squares in a large circle format. Number each chair or square with a different number. Put the same numbers on pieces of paper and put them in a box. Players walk around the circle to music. When the music is stopped, players sit in the chair or stand on the square closest to them. A number is drawn from a box. The person sitting in the chair or standing in the square with the same number wins. The winner is awarded a pastry or prize. Not all numbers need to be played to start the game. If no one is sitting or standing on the number drawn, there is no winner for that game. To start a new game, clear the game area and collect tickets each time.

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
