HOW TO USE THIS PLANNING SHEET!

Planning out all the amazing craft ideas that you'd like to accomplish for your special day can be stressful, so use this planning sheet to help you keep track of it all!

PROJECT: Start by identifying the project, like invitations, a directional sign, bridesmaid gift bags or maybe even bridal shower favors.

BUDGET: This one is important. Set your budget for the project and do not spend more than what you've allowed. We've all seen the meme, "Why buy something for \$9 when I can make it for \$95" - dont' be that gal. Use coupons to buy supplies, borrow tools from friends and shop online to find the best deals

ESTIMATED TIME: how long do you think the project will take you? Round up in your estimation to give yourself a comfortable time cushion.

COMPLETE BY: Set the date of when the project needs to be completed, maybe even a few days before it *must* be done, just to be safe.

START BY: Using your "estimated time + complete by" decide when you need to start the project and when you'll need to buy all the supplies for it as well.

COMPLETED ____ and then happily check off the box when your done!

Print off as many sheets as you need, possibly even a few different times during your planning process as you revise and refine your DIY plans. This type of organization will ensure that your wedding projects are not only fabulous but that you'll actually be able to enjoy the process of creating them, because you won't be rushed or stressed!
