HERE'S HOW YOU DO IT

- 1. Trace, score and cut out the purse box template. Assemble the box using double-sided tape.
- 2. Cut a strip of patterned paper. Cut a length of ribbon and adhere the ribbon to the top of the patterned paper strip making sure to wrap the ends of the ribbon around the back of the paper strip. Adhere the strip to the front of the purse. Repeat this step for the back of the purse.
- 3. To create ribbon handles, cut off the handles of the paper purse. Cut two 6" lengths of ribbon and adhere the ends to the inside of the paper purse.
- 4. Punch a small hole in the top right hand corner of the box and attach a flower to the purse using a brad.
